To promote access to cultural activities, in particular by organizing classical music concerts in the local area	Cultural activities strengthen the bonds in community but some factors such as distance or cost might prevent the audience from participating. By bringing arts and music in particular to South London the company endeavours to help local community get engaged and to attract people from all socio-economic backgrounds, and to enhance cultural life in balance with that of more affluent and centrally located areas
To improve participation in arts and music by organising events that bring artists and the audiences closer together, such as intimate recitals, workshops, talks and “meet the artists” opportunities	The company aims to address preconceptions that might inhibit some people from participating in concerts and art, by building a positive, engaged and informative image in which the barriers between the art, artists and guests are diminished
To provide creative and cultural space for the community	The company was set-up with the objective of providing rehearsal and recital space for musicians requiring the use of historical keyboard instruments, at the time when no other space created specifically for that purpose has been known to the founders. The company’s venue also provides opportunity to display artwork and can serve as a venue for local clubs and communities meetings.
To support independent artists	The company’s activities and events feature both established and starting artists, including students and recent graduates from art and music colleges, providing them with opportunity to show their work, and for the audiences to support the artists
